It has been some days now that I haven't sent any log. I've been kept quite busy with the development for the next ECM but I still keep on monitoring a bit every day.

Summary:

- KoinVizion is still way back with sending the cards to the customers but he sent a mail to a user of the DR7 forum saying that he is going to release an ECM V4 that will be more resistant to ECM's. It seems that existing and new dealers will now make cards that will self-destroy if someone tries to dump them. [Ref. 1 & 6]
- The people on the forums are still discussing the way the DNASP003 works but they have already figured out many things. A lot of people have killed their cards because they have been writing in the first bytes of the OTE. A lot of wrong informations are still being published on the sites. Now the hackers are getting rid of the LOOK channels to have an ECM-proof card. The main fear for them now is the next ECM. [Ref. 2 & 7 & 11]
- A user on DR7 says that his dealer pretends to be able to ESMize the DNASP010 cards (AKA 288-03). No proof about that yet but the people on the boards are wondering why they can't dump the DNASP010. [Ref. 3 & 8]
- A fully commented disassembly of the DNASP003 ROM code and its EEPROM has been published early this week. The comments are from Stuntguy. JohnnyASIC notes that there is no way that Stuntguy has been able to comment the whole code since its release right before Christmas. It seems obvious that Stuntguy already had the code before it was released. [Ref. 4]
- TALK 3.1d and a program called "SorryCharlie" can now dump the DNASP002 cards. TALK 3.1d can also write the EEPROM of these cards. [Ref. 5 & 9]
- Key-View is mad at Digital Adventures and considers them as scammers now. They seemed to work hand in hand some time ago but the guys at Digital Adventures seems to have left the business (with the cards and the money of their customers); Key-View doesn't give up though and still announces the EK-2. They also threaten to publish the names of the Digital Adventures' owners on their web site. [Ref. 10]
- ESMCards seem to have left the business for good. They don't reply to their customers anymore. The commercial market is now turning towards unlooping. The latest reports say that nobody is able to unloop the DNASP002 cards killed in December for the moment. [Ref. 12]

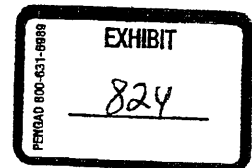
