Summary:
 - Many users are complaining about KoinVizion. He doesn't send their cards back and he doesn't reply to e-mails. Now the opinion on the boards is that KoinVizion is "history". [Ref. 1]
 - Nobody bothered to make a blocker code for the DNASP002 to prevent a possible update yet. The most knowledgeable hackers think that there is not enough space in the EEPROM to load the same patch as we did load on the DNASP003 cards. [Ref. 2]

Since this log is very short and that I will have to leave for the army on Monday, I'd like to give my POV about the current situation. Not much is happening on the forums now. The hacking is stalling it seems. The number of hackers who still have non-updated cards is very limited and therefore the blocker code that has been published cannot be widely used. Most hackers now think that the AVR is the way to go, which is right for the moment (till the next ECM). I'd like to emphasize (again) on the fact that the AVR3 is not a device for the newbie. To make it work properly some good knowledge of the system is needed. Besides, people have to reprogram the device quite often because it looks like the code is bugged and the device by itself is not always properly built. Also, at most dealers' the AVR3 is now out of stock. IMHO the AVR3 isn't a great threat for us. This device generates a lot of posts on the forums because it's hard to configure and it's buggy but I don't think that the percentage of people actually using it is very high.

DNASP002 : Compromised. Freeware available. Many cards dead.
 DNASP003 : Secured. VIP rights in some cards. Cards in blockers not affected by the update.
 DNASP010 : Not compromised.
 AVR3/blocker: Working (MCG 3.05).

 E3MCards : Site totally closed until new ISP is found.
