Since Satellite Business News has reported that the P4 has been cracked, many hackers have expressed their opinions on various DTV forums. Here is what comes out:

- This hack cannot be verified since nothing has been released. Most pirates will not believe until they see a working release.
- Some people think that it would be foolish to brag about such a hack before the swap is done. They say that this could lead DTV to suspend or even cancel the swap, thus rendering the hack useless.
- A guy who calls himself "datastream50" says that he can hack the P4 and that he's willing to prove it to a forum's moderator.
- Some respected hackers claim that the algorithm contained in the ASIC of DTV's cards "has been cracked" (i.e. is known) but that the master key (needed to make a cardless hack) is still unknown.
- According to some tests the P4 would to be immune to glitching (at least to some extent).
