some time off from work (injury), I have had far too much time on my  
hands. I have gone into the EchoStar's IRD Memory Dump & Diagnostics  
screen. Upon entering that screen, I have started a manual type dump  
of everything in the IRD's memory. I have also already dumped a hex  
file of the card. It was 512 bytes large. Interesting how much NVRAM  
that it holds. I would have thought it might hold more than that,  
but at the beginning of the card dump, shows the familiar for  
letters. "BUFA". These same letters are shown in the IRD's System  
Information Screen under SOFTWARE Version and Boot Strap Version. If  
anyone would like a copy of this dump, I would be more than happy to

Yeah, the NVRAM stuff on the receiver's screen (biatch: go to the diagnostics menu, then hit INFO-right arrow-left arrow) is the IRD's EEPROM, not the card's. The EEPROM in the card is at least 4096 bytes long. What's really interesting is looking at the differences in the NVRAM stuff in various receivers...I've got a couple of 1000s I'm using for experiments, and their NVRAM is pretty worthless. I've got a 5000 and a HDSR-100U that both have things like favorite channel lists in the IRD EEPROM, etc. Lots of stuff stored in there in straight ASCII, too.

I'm guessing that "BUFA" is a signature that the E\* people use to allow them to know that the EEPROM is initialized.
